

The Hills Park and Nature Trail Commission
Meeting Minutes
April 13th, 2010

In attendance: Rick Zehrer, Josh Avigael, Scott Feil, Bruce Warmuth, Adrienne Peters, and Mary Ann Grimes

Meeting commenced at 1pm with Rick Zehrer presiding and Mary Ann Grimes taking minutes.

March minutes approved and signed.

Treasurer's Report: Josh reported that in March we paid \$2918.33 for the parking lot and road gravel/repair, \$1135.95 for plumbing repairs. We also paid for cleaning and for water which included a credit for the leak.

Old Business

Tripping Hazard: Project completed and repairs made by Scott

Nature Guide: Betty Ann to coordinate with Diane on the types of plants and their location for the Nature Guide. She will bring an example of the guide at the next meeting.

Par Course and Sandbox: Rick coordinating with Kim Hall

Leveling the Playing Field: The playing field used to be a dumping site for construction prior to becoming a part of The Park. Since we do not know what is under the grass, Jason will be boring holes to get samples of what is underground. This will give us an idea of the work and expense involved in this project.

Gravel under berm slide: Rick and Scott dug up the compacted soil and raked the gravel into place.

Tether Ball: Rick to attempt to replace the tether ball using a strong coated wire to secure the ball.

Path from Autumn Oaks to Park: Dan Roark will be putting together a plan and present it to the BOA and Park members. The current object is to make a new path and discourage people from walking on the driveway and lawns of the neighboring properties.

POA Covered Dish Event: Scheduled for the evening of May 1st, the POA will host a covered dish get together for The Hills community. The commission plans to have some of its members meet prior to the event to make sure The Park facilities are clean and in order and grounds are in good shape. Grass to be mowed prior to event.

New Business

Gravel/entry gate saga: The gate at the Serene Hills entrance was damaged by the gravel truck and needed repairing. The POA paid \$200 towards the repair.

Date for 10th Anniversary of The Park: The Park was deeded to The Hills on October 9, 2000 and was dedicated as The Park, May 11th, 2002. This next fall we would like to celebrate to anniversary of The Park at the ICS. Date to be determined.
