August 10, 2010

Old Business

- **Par Course and sandbox:** Everything is lined up and the hardware will be purchased before the end of the fiscal year.
- **Path from Autumn Oaks to Park:** This has been resolved. The MUS will line the ditch and a path will not be constructed. All landscaping will be paid by the adjacent homeowners.
- **Ice Cream Social:** A meeting is pending with Park commission members Betty Ann Courtney, Scott Feil, Josh Avigael and Angela Thielemans from the POA. They will be coordinating efforts and funding for the newly named "Hill's Fest." Hoppin House has already been donated by the POA.
- **Commission member "Replacements":** Suzy Aubert submitted to BOA for approval. Rick will speak with Keith Tilley (Friend of the Park) to gauge his interest in becoming a new commission member.
- **Budget for 2010-11 Fiscal Year:** Josh will circulate preliminary budget before the next meeting via email. Minus major projects. Funds for gravel for the trail will be included. Rick suggested that we look into a shade cover for the small playscape. Maintaining the rock creek is a problem as rocks are being moved. Betty Ann suggested that we line the corners of the path with rock boundaries. Rick will check with Dan Roark about the estimates for the leveling of the field. Josh will check on pricing for the playscape cover.

New Business

- **Wasps:** It was suggested that all members be on the lookout for wasps while they are in the park and for other insect infestations.
