IMPORTANT

- Carts should be placed within two (2) feet of the edge of the street with the handle toward the curb. Recycle bin should be five (5) feet from trash bin.
- Trash containers, trash bags and recycling materials are to be put out only on Mondays.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

PLASTIC

- * Jugs and bottles with recycle symbol # 1-5 & 7 (check bottom of container)
- * Remove lids and rinse, labels may be left on.
- * Clean frozen food trays, plastic takeout containers, plastic plates, cups and utensils (check for recycling #)



ALUMINUM AND STEEL CANS

- * Aluminum cans (soda) tin & steel (such as soup & tuna) , empty aerosol, metal lids from glass jars

GLASS

- * Clear, green & amber glass.
- * Glass containers and their lids can go in with the rest of your recycling, labels can remain on .



NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINES

- * Newspaper and Magazines
- * Advertising inserts are okay
- * Envelopes labels and windows are okay
- * Home office paper, stickies, manilla envelopes & file folders are okay.



- * Boxboard, phone books, greeting cards are okay.
- * Paper bags are okay except gift bags

CORRUGATE CARDBOARD

- *Corrugated cardboard (moving and mailing boxes) are okay.

TRASH

SERVICE GUIDELINES

Place trash and recycling at curbside by 7:00 a.m. each Monday. When Christmas and/or New year's day fall on Monday, pickup will be the following Tuesday.

Cut brush and tree trimmings to 3ft and tie in bundles

At Christmas time, IESI will pick up your Christmas trees at no additional charge. Trees may be up to six feet in length. Christmas trees taller than six feet must be cut in half by the resident.

One cart plus up to 4 plastic bags of trash picked up weekly. Use of cart is optional.

Empty trash cans should be promptly stored out of sight

Physically challenged residents may request special service.
