WHEREAS, the Board of Alderman of the Village of The Hills recognizes the importance of Lake Travis' water quality to the health, economic and recreational interest of the City's residents;

WHEREAS, the water consumed by the City's residents is derived directly from Lake Travis, a water body known for its superior water quality;

WHEREAS, there has been an on-going assault on Lake Travis water quality that is expected to continue through the coming months and years;

WHEREAS, the Board of Alderman recognizes and applauds the Travis County Commissioners Court for its demonstrated leadership in support for a clean Lake Travis; and

WHEREAS, Travis County Precinct 3 Commissioner Karen Huber has proposed a regional economic study on the value of a clean Lake Travis (the "Study") and is seeking support from the public.

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Board of Alderman of the Village of The Hills to support the Study in the amount of \$500 to be conveyed to Travis County upon its authorization for contracting such a Study.
